COURSE: JH will run 2 miles. High school races will be 5K

ENTRY FEE: \$50 per team, \$100 Total

If not a full team it will be \$8.00 per individual.

For junior varsity runners there will be a charge of \$5.00 per runner.

Junior high will be \$30 per team, or \$5.00 per runner, whichever amount is less

SCORING: In the Varsity races you may **run seven** runners and the best **five** will be scored.

\*\*\*Junior Varsity and Junior High is unlimited entries.

The meet is being scored by Morgan Sports.

MEDALS: Medals will be awarded immediately following the completion of the last race. Medals will be awarded to the top **10** individual runners in each varsity race and **5** medals to the top runners in both the JV Boys & JV Girls division. Medals will also be awarded to the top **two** teams in each division. The winning team in each division will also receive a championship plaque. The top **10** individual runners in both JH boys and girls races will be awarded medals.

## **COVID 19 Protocols**

### **NCAA League Fall Fan Expectations and Procedures**

**Each school may add additional restrictions for their facilities based on local health departments mandates. To ensure the safety of student athletes and in an attempt to continue competition, the league or individual school may determine to limit or restrict fan attendance at any time.**

#### **Cross Country-**

- Teams should not gather at the start line until 5 minutes before the start. Pre Race huddles can take place at team camps. Masks are recommended at the start line for athletes, but not mandatory.
