Running Events:	No preliminaries. All running events will be finals -vs- time. Running events will take precedence over field events during the meet.	
Rules:	All NSAA rules will be followed. We will be flexible in regard to uniform rule. No marking of any kind on the runways or aprons. Marks must be placed to the sides of these areas. Do not place tape on the track for relays. Deliberate defacing can lead to disqualification.	
Locker Rooms:	Will not be available.	
Concessions:	Will be available at the track.	
Restrooms:	Restrooms available at northeast end of track.	
Scoring:	We will score: 10-8-6-4-2-1 in individual events and 8-6-4-2 in relays. You may enter as many individuals as you want in an event, as long as it does not violate the four event per individual rule. Only your top 3 athletes in an event are scored or will receive medals.	
Spikes:	Athletes must use 1/8" or less.	
Cancellation or Postponement:	If weather conditions exist that are unsafe and unfavorable for the meet, information will be broadcast on Superior's radio station, KRFS, (1600AM-103.9FM) Please list a phone number and time of departure on your entry form so that we can notify your school in this situation.	
Team Camps:	Please help keep the facilities clean by supervising your athletes. Make sure all the trash gets thrown away.	
Buses:	Bus parking is available on south west side of the high school next to the Tennis courts.	
Meet Results & Awards:	Plaques for champion boys and girls teams. Medals for places 1-8 will be awarded for individual events and 1-6 for relays. Medals and plaques, along with complete meet results will be available shortly after the meet at the concession stand area.

Track & Field Online Entries System

Instructions for Attending Coaches

1. Go to the Sydex website (www.sydexsports.com), and click on "Track Online Meet Entries".

2. The main page for Online Entries appears. Click "Roster Setup/Send Entries to a Meet".

3. The login screen appears. Type in your <u>User Name</u> and <u>Password</u> if you are a returning user. First-time users, click "Register as New User", fill in the fields, and click Proceed. The next screen asks for your team information. Fill in according to the on-screen directions.

4. On the Meet Selection screen, select your meet then click "Proceed to Add/Change Rosters...".

5. You are now successfully logged into the meet. Please review the meet information (bottom of screen), taking note of any "Special Instructions" given by the meet host.

6. Enter your rosters with the "View/Edit Roster" buttons. Follow all instructions, making sure to enter athlete grade/class if your host requires it! (You will be shown on-screen if it is needed).

7. Once you've entered your roster, return to the main screen. The events are listed in boxes --- men on the left, women on the right. To begin, click on the first event in the list, then click "Add/Change Event Entries". Note: if you have already put entries into a different meet with the Sydex online system, you may use the "Load Entries from Previous Meet" button. This will put previously entered athletes into the events, along with any seed marks you entered. Follow all instructions, clicking "Go To Next Event" as you work through the events. Click the "Confirm Entries and Return..." button when you are finished.

8. After all the athletes are in events, you may view your work by returning to the previous screen and clicking "View a List of Your Entries". You may either view entries by event, or by athlete.

9. To send the email of your entries to the host, click "Email your Entries to Host". You may send this email more than once, if necessary.
