COVID PROTOCOLS

The following are protocols that are expected to be followed at events being held at Beloit Jr/Sr High School.

GENERAL EXPECTATIONS

- *Social distancing to be practiced as much as possible
- *Masks will be worn at all times during indoor activities and in common spaces at outside events (ticket entrance, restrooms, concessions, stands if social distancing is not possible)
- *Temperatures will be taken for all fans attending events at BJSHS

FOOTBALL

- Please temperature check your athletes prior to departing for Beloit. Anyone with a fever or not feeling well should not travel.
- Your team will be provided with a locker room that has been disinfected prior to your arrival
- Teams will be required to wear masks when in our locker rooms or hallways.
- Our locker situation at the stadium is not ideal. You can use the endzone or high jump area or please contact me to discuss other options.
- Postgame there will not be a handshake line. Please have a plan for an appropriate sign of sportsmanship at the end of the contest.

NCAA League Fall Fan Expectations and Procedures

Each school may add additional restrictions for their facilities based on local health departments mandates. To ensure the safety of student athletes and in an attempt to continue competition, the league or individual school may determine to limit or restrict fan attendance at any time.

Cross Country-

Masks will be worn by fans in shared common spaces where social distancing cannot be maintained. Example: Within 200 meters of the start/finish line, restrooms and team tents. Masks may be removed if social distancing can be maintained. Fan/Parents are not allowed in team spaces.

Masks will be required for entry and at shared common spaces where social distancing cannot be maintained. Example: Concessions, restrooms, and main entries. Masks may be removed if social distancing can be maintained. Social distancing practices in the stands. ALL patrons must be in designated fan areas.

Volleyball-

Masks will be required for entry into all league venues. Masks must be worn at all times by fans/spectators and social distancing is encouraged in the stands.

Other NCAA League Fall Sports Expectations:

- Exact change is recommended for all purchases.
- Concessions will be limited to pre-packaged food items and bottled drinks.
- Senior nights may be adjusted throughout the season.
- Teams will need to do temp checks prior to loading the busses for away events
- Masks are required for common spaces at outdoor events (Subject to being asked to leave)
- No shared locker rooms when hosting events
- Locker rooms are cleaned by host school before visitors arrive
- Order of play may change due to limited availability of officials
- Schools will attempt to livestream as much as possible
- Modify post game and/or sportsmanship handshakes
