Barring any last minute changes, we will have (3) teams in each pool, one at the high school and one at the grade school. The winner of one pool will play the runner up of the other pool and vice versa. The third place finisher in each pool will play each other. A single net will be used in each gym.

Pool A (High School)

*Smith Center, Concordia, and Beloit

Pool B (Grade School)

*Phillipsburg, Republic County, and TMP

**After all three pool play matches are complete, the first place finisher in Pool A will play the runner up in pool B at the high school. The first place finisher in Pool B will play the runner up from pool A also at the high school. While these matches are being played, the two third place finishers will play each other at the grade school. The finals will be at the high school and the 3rd place matches will be at the grade school. All schools need to supply their own libero trackers as well.

I need to also add that all spectators will be required to wear masks in the building at all times.

This may be inconvenient at times, but so is everything else during these times.

Semifinals (High School)

- 12:15 Pool A Winner vs. Pool B Runner Up

 3rd Place Finishers play each other at the grade school.
 - 1:15 Pool B Winner vs. Pool A Runner Up
 - 2:15 Winners of semifinals play for first
 - 2:30 Losers of semifinals play for 3rd at the grade school.

(We will run ahead of schedule if time permits. If a team or teams are deemed unable to come, then everything changes.

Tie breaker procedure:

- 1) Head to Head
- 2) Won-loss percentage in pool play matches
- 3) Defensive points allowed.
