Meet Cost: As stated in the contract, **\$130 per school.**

Entries: Each school may enter 3 individuals in the running events and one relay team. Each school may enter 4 individuals in each field event. Each individual may be entered in 4 individual events. Please have entries completed by **Friday, April 19th.** You may make scratches at the coaches meeting at 2:15pm in the HS library. No additions will be added after Sunday, April 26th.

Medals: Medals will be awarded for the first 3 individual places and the first 3 relays. Medals will be placed in packets and given to the coaches following the meet.

Results: Results will be available following the meet at the press box.

Shoes: The track is rubberized. Maximum spike length: $\frac{1}{4}$ " (preferred: $\frac{3}{16}$ "). **Please bring markers other than tape for the jumps/relay marks.** The pole vault, long jump, and high jump approaches are also rubberized and require the same $\frac{1}{4}$ inch spikes. Please help us monitor this. The javelin approach is grass. The shot and discus rings are cement.

Heats: In the running events without preliminaries, we will place the faster runners in the last heat.

Scoring: 10-8-6-4-2-1 (Top 6 Places)

Field Event Workers: Each school attending has been assigned a field event. Please make note of the event you are to work. You will only have to supply someone to run/be in charge of the event. We will supply (with our JH Track Team) the workers to aid in marking and measuring.

This meet is using free online registration at Athletic.net!

Athletic.net is a resource for Track & Field and Cross Country coaches, offering free **statistic tracking**, easy **meet registrations**, free **meet managers**, and free tools to simplify common coaching tasks.

Follow the 4 steps below to get started:

1. [Sign up for a free coach account](#) (if you do not have one)

- Go to the website: www.athletic.net
- Click on '[Log In](#)' in the upper right hand corner, and then click '**Sign Up**' on the bottom of that screen.
- Complete the signup wizard
- After receiving the confirmation email, go on to #2

2. Add meets to your season calendar

- **Log In** to Athletic.net

- Navigate to the [Events page](#)
- Start typing **Washington County MS & HS Invitational** into the Search Box
- Expand the meet card, and find the button to add this meet to your teams calendar
- Repeat this process for the rest of your season calendar (*You can also find meets by date and location*)
- If a meet is not listed, you can add it to your calendar by clicking 'Add new Event' and following the wizard
- Verify that your calendar is correct. Click on a Meet, then the pencil icon to make corrections to a meet, or use the trash can icon to delete a meet.

3. Enter team roster

- Navigate to your team page by opening the side menu, then click on your team.
- Click on Manage Team
- Click on Edit Roster under Athletes
- Add athletes to the roster manually, or upload your roster using the "Upload Athlete Roster" option.

4. Register athletes for Washington County MS & HS Invitational

- Locate **Washington County HS Invitational** on your team's main Track and Field page and click on it
- Click "**Register Athletes**"
- Follow instructions on the meet registration page to enter your athletes into the appropriate division(s).
- Use the "Add an athlete" buttons to add athletes to your roster if needed.
