- Fans/spectators need to sit as a family unit and be six feet from other family units. We will have the bleachers marked to help with this.
- Fans/spectators are not allowed near participating groups or on the court.
- Players and team personnel will wear masks when not on court in competition
- Each player should supply their own water bottle with their name on it.

With your help, we hope these protocols will be sufficient to allow us to continue to offer volleyball for our student-athletes. If circumstances occur that make it difficult to follow these protocols we will then have to go to a ticket system for entry to our games.

- Parking spots can be reserved for SES patrons along the fence just north of the entry gate. You can watch the game from your car. Limited spots available. Please contact the Athletic office if interested.
- Masks will be required to enter the game
- Masks are required at all common spaces where social distance cannot be maintained. Including but not limited to - concessions, rest room, entry/exit gate.
- Masks may be removed in the stands if able to social distance.
- Fans/spectators need to sit as a family unit and be six feet from other family units.
- No standing along the press box area please sit with your family.
- Fans/spectators are not allowed near participating groups or on the field.
- Band (if in attendance) will social distance on the south side of bleachers one section from south end
- Student section will be on the far south end of bleachers. Social distancing will be expected.

With your help, we hope these protocols will be sufficient to allow us to continue to offer football for our student-athletes. If our crowd size becomes so large that we can't follow these protocols we will then have to go to a ticket system for entry to our games.
